The Goal

The goal of most of these strategies is simple:

To find only the "highest-profit" products that give you high profit margins and therefore require less work.

To "automate" as much of this product-sourcing as possible, leaving you more time to make money.

I know you're excited to learn these proven strategies, so let's get started now!

1 – Antique Mall Buyout Offer

In the early '90s, I sold vintage Hot Wheels in an antique toy store in Fullerton, CA.

I had a consignment case there.

One day, I received an interesting call...

1 – Antique Mall Buyout Offer

Step-By-Step:

- **1.** Visit local Antique Malls
- 2. Scope out the ones that have highly collectible items
- **3.** Offer to buy out the entire space (at favorable wholesale pricing)
- **4.** Close the deal and begin selling at high profits!

Exhibitors at Trade Shows have a variety of responsibilities tied to their trade show booth.

One of their responsibilities is breaking down and shipping out their booth and products.

You can help them by offering to "buy out" their booth / products at the end of the show.

Step-By-Step:

1. Find trade shows that are coming to your area (TSNN.com)

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2. Find those with highly-saleable items – items that are in high demand

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- **4.** Close the deal and begin selling at high profits!
- 5. There's even a way to profit from trade shows WITHOUT attending them!

(Trade Show No Show training)

I've bought tens of thousands of vintage Hot Wheels by advertising for them.

Initially, I ran ads in local "freebie" classified ad newspapers and then I found more automated / internet ways to accomplish the same thing.

Advertising for product is an age-old technique used by antiques dealers for years – but it WORKS!

Many people still live in the "offline world" and have not set foot on the internet yet!

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I bought a collection of loose, vintage Hot Wheels from him and this car was in that collection.



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
Years later, when I was in "raising money mode", I called a friend, who had expressed interest in this car...

\$3,000!

Step-By-Step:

- Find your local classified ads newspapers. (PennySaver, Thrifty Nickel, Hot Sheet, Recycler, Etc.)
- 2. Check into their advertising policies often you can get free "resident" ads
- 3. Run some initial test ads to see how your response is BUT, remember that advertising works best through repetition...
- 4. Re-run your ads as they begin working and then expand to larger regions / cities

4 – Advertising For Consignment Deals

You can sell for others on Amazon / eBay on consignment.

In this arrangement, you're selling other people's merchandise *for them*, for a percentage of the sale.

I've had lots of six-figure success stories who used this business model.

The trick is to sell only higher-end / high-profit items, such as vehicles, jewelry – anything that will pay you well when you make 20% - 40% of the sale.

4 – Advertising For Consignment Deals

Step-By-Step:

- **1.** Run ads in your local classified ads newspapers. (PennySaver, Thrifty Nickel, Hot Sheet, Recycler, Etc.)
- 2. Get business cards / postcards printed with your ad
- 3. Run ads stating that you will sell their stuff for them specify the types of things you'll sell for them

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- I don't buy them to resell

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- I don't buy them to resell
- I don't ship them

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- I don't build them
- I don't touch them
- I don't buy them to resell
- I don't ship them

I only sell them, (on my website) and make \$70 each time I sell one!

My friend, (who I've created this exclusive arrangement with)

- Buys the materials
- Builds the cases
- Packs and ships the cases
- And gets paid his price

(I simply "mark it up" by \$70 – my commission)

One of my success stories did this with stage monitors and made \$14,000 a month with very little time invested!

Step-By-Step:

- **1.** Find handmade or high-quality products that there's a demand for
- 2. You can find these products by searching on Etsy, at crafts shows, at trade shows, by advertising for these situations or on specialty websites
- Create an exclusivity agreement that allows you to be the ONLY seller on eBay / Amazon for their item
- **4.** Start selling!

I love classic cars and I've had a blast buying and selling cars on eBay!

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I've made the most money in one transaction on eBay by selling this car on eBay Motors:



Bought: \$38,000 Paid: \$3,000 for repairs Sold: for \$69,000 Profit: \$28,000

Step-By-Step:

- Find classic cars locally by searching for them or hiring a "bird dog" on a commission basis
- 2. Negotiate a great deal locally from "don't wanter" sellers
- 3. Advertise that you sell cars on eBay Motors on consignment
- 4. Contact local used car dealers and offer to sell their cars for them (but charge a "listing fee" per car listed)
- 5. Sell less but make more!

7 – Flea Market Finds

Flea markets are good places to source products – if you know what you're looking for!

Some of the cool products to look for at flea markets:

- "Like-new" closeout merchandise
- High-demand marketing courses (CDs/ DVDs / Workbooks)
- Workout DVD sets and rare media items in general
- Furbys
- Collectible toys
- Collectible books
- Excedrin

7 – Flea Market Finds

Look for large lots of new merchandise that you can buy wholesale.

Flea market sellers understand "giving a good deal when you buy everything"

Negotiate hard – they're used to it

Media items are good finds at flea markets - they sell well on Amazon

7 – Flea Market Finds

- The best flea markets are the ones where most of the sellers sell "used stuff". Many of these items are from storage auctions. Also good are the Antique Fle Markets (for collectibles)
- 2. The early bird gets the DEAL! Get there as early as possible and bring lots of cash
- 3. Bundle deals or "lots" mean better deals overall

If you are focused on one main niche in your eBay / Amazon business, it's a good idea to get a business card to hand out wherever you go.

A card is like having "1000 salespeople".

This isn't a standard business card, though.

Here's an example of one of mine (postcard size)



I've gotten a lot of deals with this method, especially when going to flea markets and handing them out to dealers who are selling items similar to mine.

I once bought a vintage Hot Wheels collection because the collectible toys dealer could not afford to buy it and he handed my card to the seller.

Made about \$1,800 on that deal!

I use VistaPrint.com and the cards are super inexpensive to print!

- **1.** Decide the high-demand / collectibles niche you want to be in.
- 2. Print up cards similar to the one I just showed you
- 3. Take the cards with you, everywhere you go and hand them out, leave them places where your "prospects" might hang out and just distribute the heck out of them
- **4.** Receive calls and go buy the stuff!

9 – Buying Events

In my niche of collectible and vintage toys, there is a major seller who buys all of their merchandise through "Buying Events".

They've got it down to a science...

In their buying events, they treat it like the "Antiques Roadshow" and have people bring in their collectible toys for an "appraisal".

They are usually communicating with someone at the office who gives them a buy price (based on their eBay research)

9 – Buying Events

They get set up in a hotel ballroom and they also get a lot of pre-event advertising going, such as press releases, full page newspaper ads and radio ads and radio interviews.

Since they are the sole buyers, they are in a prime negotiating position.

When they buy an item or a collection from you, they pay with a check.

By doing these buying events, they make tons of money because they often get some of the rarest items (pre-production and prototype toys) that sell for tens of thousands of dollars.

This is the big leagues!

9 – Buying Events

- **1.** Start small with a smaller hotel room or an inexpensive office location that is rented for a few hours.
- 2. The key to this is advertising everywhere and often so that you get lots of people coming to your event.
- **3.** Have plenty of cash, carefully guarded, or use checks.
- **4.** Have someone who really knows how to research items there (or available by phone) that's their sole job.
- **5.** Start buying up collections!

10 – Search Craigslist Nationally

Craigslist is a free classifieds website where people post things they want to sell.

However, Craigslist is intentionally run as a LOCAL classified ads site...

Craigslist only allows you to search in one region or one major city at a time.

However, I found a great search tool that allows you to search Craigslist over a wider area or even across an entire Country at the same time, which definitely opens up the opportunities for profit!

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10 – Craigslist Arbitrage

- 1. Visit <u>SearchTempest.com</u>
- 2. Run searches for products you know are good sellers across a broad area near you.
- 3. Compare to current pricing on Amazon / eBay
- 4. If the local pricing is profitable, go buy the items & resell on Amazon / eBay

This is more of an example than a strategy, but I think we can learn a lot from it!

One day, my wife sent me an article from Yahoo News about how people were paying big money for Excedrin on eBay...

The article talked about a voluntary recall by Novartis in which the company had taken their products off the shelves...

Apparently, for some people, Excedrin Extra Strength and Excedrin Migraine are the only products that relieve their migraines – generic brands just don't do it...

As soon as I read the article, I thought: "I know where to find Excedrin!"

The next day, I went to a local flea market and found Excedrin.

I was buying the 200 ct boxes for \$12 each and selling them for \$150

The people who bought these were so grateful – they could not find them anywhere...



I also sold Excedrin PM, Back & Body, and Tension Headache

I then started selling them on Amazon and they sold for even more money.

I made \$20,000 in 60 days by selling Excedrin on eBay / Amazon!



- **1.** Be on the lookout for recalled items / spikes in demand
- 2. Stay well informed as to where you can get these items
- 3. Have a product-sourcing mindset, wherever you go
- **4.** When the opportunity comes, be ready to strike!

Product Sourcing Arbitrage & Hacks

In the next few strategies, you'll discover some exciting arbitrage strategies using Amazon & eBay, as well as some pretty powerful "hacks" that will get you great deals!

The Goal

The goal of most of these arbitrage / hacking strategies is simple:

To use some little-known strategies that find "inefficiencies" in various markets and then to "ethically exploit" those inefficiencies to make money, more quickly and more easily than traditional ways.

Some of my best finds (on eBay) started with a simple "completed listings" search.

As I continued to "dig", I found some very interesting things about the seller and the volume of sales they were doing.


If you combine this strategy with some simple "product finding" strategies, you can reverse-engineer most sellers' businesses and often find some great products that have a high sell-through rate!

Here's an example of a product I've done really well with.


Notice that this product actually has 2 titles...

I've found quite a few of these by searching only for:

"Get Ripped In 90 Days", which is not the main title...



When an item is listed with the wrong title, most searchers (who are looking by using the correct title) will not find that item – leaving it as easy pickings for you to snipe or "buy it now" before someone else does!



- **1.** Run completed listings searches on popular / high-demand products
- 2. Find "alternate" ways that people might list these products
- **3.** Run searches for these alternate search terms
- **4.** Find bargains, buy them and resell them

When you are doing these creative searches, be on the lookout for sellers who have a high feedback rating.


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

When you find one with a great product and a high feedback rating, you can now go into "Spy mode"...

- **1.** While searching popular products, look for high-feedback sellers
- 2. Spy on them by checking their completed listings to see how much volume they're doing of a particular product
- 3. Check on other products that they may be selling a lot of
- **4**. Begin creatively searching for sources of that product.

14 – StuffAlert.com

StuffAlert will send you alerts when an item you are looking for gets listed on eBay.

Enter Keywords the			Step	2	
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14 – StuffAlert.com

- Visit <u>StuffAlert.com</u> and enter the details of the items you've found to be in high demand
- 2. Use "alternate" keywords and titles to find the items that are not typically searched that way
- **3.** Receive email updates with those high-demand items and buy them for resale.

Often, amateur eBay sellers will list an item without doing proper research as to its value...


This results in their listing being priced too low – you can snap these up, if you know what you're doing.

When most people think of sniping, they think of sniping a bid at the very end of an auction.

With "Buy It Now" sniping, we are going to snipe a purchase at the very beginning of the listing.

Once you've got a popular item in mind, run a search on eBay (using your best parameters) and then you can click "Follow this search" to have alerts emailed to you.

(Get Ripped In 90 Days)



- **1.** Enter the search that you want to "Snipe" into eBay search.
- 2. Include such parameters as: "Buy It Now", Lowest Price, "Newly Listed" and Alternate titles
- **3.** Get daily alerts emailed to you by eBay!

I've made some great money by searching items that were mis-listed...

(and therefore NOT FINDABLE by most of the people searching for them the normal ways!)

Commonly-made errors:

- Not using the PRIMARY keywords / product name in titles
- Not using secondary keywords in titles
- Not using all 80 characters in the title
- Misspelling keywords in titles
- Not giving enough details in listings

"Not In Title" search

When the item's name is not in the title, it makes that item very difficult to find by someone who is typing in the correct search term.

For example: listing a Mickey Mouse toy without the word "Mickey"

The item would get lost in a sea of "mouse" titles.

I once bought an item for 99¢ that I turned around and sold for \$71 because of this error!

A "not in title" search allows you to search the description for the keyword – this ensures that YOU find the mis-listed item, where others cannot.



17 – Finding Wholesale Lots On eBay

You can often find some great wholesale lots on eBay by creatively searching.

If you begin a search for one of your popular items and then use search terms like:

- Collection of...
- Wholesale lot of...
- Lot of...
- Group of...

You can often find larger lots. Since the odds of someone wanting a lot of one item are dramatically lower, the chance of that person selling that lot is smaller.

17 – Finding Wholesale Lots On eBay

You can often negotiate a much lower "buy it now" price with someone like that because they may not want to go through the hassle of listing the items individually.

Also, if as a result of your creative searching and "spying" you find a seller who seems to have a lot of one item, you can contact them and see if they'll sell you a "wholesale lot".

Now, you are sourcing wholesale items ON eBay!

17 – Finding Wholesale Lots On eBay

- 1. Run creative searches of popular items using the terms: wholesale, lot, group, collection, etc.
- 2. For each of those searches, create eBay "alerts" so that you are notified whenever a lot is listed with these keywords.
- **3.** Buy wholesale on eBay and sell retail!

Amazon is obviously a different ecommerce platform than eBay.

It is particularly interesting in that it has a natural downward pricing pressure built into it.

Since all sellers of an item are "sharing a listing", (there is only one listing of each item) sellers are constantly trying to "outdo" each others' price by lowering their prices in order to sell their items first.

There is great advantage to this!

I once found a seller who had the lowest price on these workout DVDs on Amazon.

I did a few simple things to determine how many they had and then contacted them with a simple inquiry:



"I'm interested in buying your workout DVDs wholesale, and I can pick them up from your location."



"I'm interested in buying your workout DVDs wholesale, and I can pick them up from your location."


They agreed, and I bought 40 of these for \$6 each!



- Search for popular / high demand items on Amazon do a trial run order from the seller in the "Buy Box".
- 2. Edit your order quantity to a high number to get an idea of how many of these items the seller has.
- 3. Contact the seller about a wholesale deal. Most people would rather sell of their entire inventory of a product and take their profits to move onto another product!



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Many people think this no longer works, but it does, if you use a special tool!

The idea with searching misspelling is that, if someone misspells one of their MAIN keywords in the title of their listing, it will be very difficult for a searcher to find that item if they CORRECTLY spell it in their search.

Although eBay DOES have a spell-check tool in their search engine, it does not cover ALL possible misspellings.

You can still find valuable, misspelled items by using your misspelled keyword in "quotes".

- 3. FatFingers.com will find multiple misspelling variations AND search eBay for you under each of those misspellings, allowing you to find all kinds of "unfindable"

items!

20 - Amazon >> eBay Profits

Once you're good at this creative searching, you can (and will) find products that are incorrectly listed on eBay – buy them – and, once they're in your possession, list them on Amazon. (either merchant-fulfilled or FBA)

You can now take advantage of the pricing and attitude differences between the two marketplaces.

Amazon tends to be more upscale than eBay and generally has better customers who don't refund or return items as readily as on eBay.

The key is to know your market and know which items are going to be popular on Amazon.

20 - Amazon >> eBay Profits

- **1.** Using your newly-found creative searching on eBay skills, find high demand products that you can resell on Amazon.
- 2. Buy them low (or wholesale) and
- **3.** Resell them high on Amazon
- **4.** Remember that often, you won't make a nice profit unless you NEGOTIATE it!

21 – Wholesale / Dropshipping

One of the most common questions I get asked as an eBay / Amazon product sourcing expert is: "Where can I find a good dropshipper?"

I try to dissuade them from doing drop shipping, because there are many drawbacks to this model and they can affect your feedback on either eBay or Amazon.

But if you want to find a quality directory of wholesalers / drop shippers, I recommend this site:

daveespino.com/recommends/salehoo

21 – Wholesale / Dropshipping

My first recommendation would be to set up your own exclusive drop shipping arrangement, like I showed you in one of the earlier lectures.

But this recommended resource actually reviews each wholesaler / dropshipper in their directory and gets ratings from people who have bought from them, so they are a much safer alternative than most other "directories".

That's why they have my recommendation.

21 – Wholesale / Dropshipping

- **1.** Visit <u>daveespino.com/recommends/salehoo</u>
- 2. Check out their additional eBay / ecommerce training for free!

22 – Deep Googling

Some wholesalers have websites that they don't really actively promote – but their products are listed online.

I've found some great wholesale deals by using what I call Deep Googling.

22 – Deep Googling

For example, I once discovered a fitness DVD (through reverse engineering a powerseller's listing) that was selling well on eBay.

When I did some deep googling, I found this exact DVD (in large quantities) on an ecommerce site by Googling the name of the DVD + "Add to cart" / "Buy now" / "order" and then going deep in the Google results.

The website had them for \$2.99 (w free shipping) and I was able to sell them for \$12.00

And, when someone ordered the DVD from me on eBay, I would just go to this site and order it on their behalf, with the shipping address being my customer's address!

22 – Deep Googling

- **1.** Find a high-demand product
- 2. Go to Google and search for the product name + "Add To Cart" / "Order" / "Buy Now"
- 3. Go DEEP 10 20 pages to see if you can find that product on an ecommerce site or on a wholesaler's website at a reduced price.

23 – Tips To Getting Great Craigslist Deals

When you are looking for great deals on Craigslist, here are a few tips.

- **1.** Jump on deals quickly
- 2. Respond to ads enthusiastically
- 3. When you say you will show up show up!
- 4. Be safe (higher the dollar amount, the more careful you are)

24 – Home Shows, Boat Shows, Car Shows

Every year, there are home shows, boat shows, RV shows and auto shows that are geared to the consumer... These shows are often where new products are introduced.

You can attend these shows and talk to the vendors / exhibitors about their products – that's what they're there for!

This can be a great source for new, exciting merchandise and you can possibly lock in an exclusive drop shipping arrangement on Amazon or eBay!

Home and garden shows

If you own a home and have never been to a Home and Garden Show, this is a great opportunity to see what you've been missing. 
